3D laserscanning within Forensics - gun rampage in Hamburg-Hamm

On 06 April 2011 a gunman opened fire in Hamburg-Hamm (Germany). The tragic outcome of this criminal act was that two people lost their lives and two more are seriously injured. Shortly after the action, the crime scene was scanned by experts from the local CID in Hamburg. The laser scanner was used to "freeze" the crime scene and allow to reconstruct the sequence of events.



At first it was not clear how the act happened and from where the first shots were fired. After a short period of time the police discerned that the offender shot from a place close to Hamm's Market Square.

Initially everyone assumed the gunshots were fired at underground station "Hammer Kirche", because one of the victims managed to escape to this place. So far not all the background details have been explained. But one thing is certain: The 3D data will help the police to visualize the whole crime scene better. Even after many years the data will still be available.

In this case the collection of data was realised with the Z+F IMAGER 5006i.
